Bratislava, March 30, 2023 – The most technologically advanced hospital in Slovakia deserves a laboratory at the same cutting-edge level. As Bory Hospital opens its doors, Unilabs Slovakia's laboratory network is starting its operations within the hospital to primarily serve its needs.

Slovakia has a new hospital and a new diagnostic laboratory, with Unilabs Slovakia occupying more than 500 square meters inside. It will be providing patients and doctors with comprehensive laboratory and diagnostic services in clinical biochemistry, haematology, serology, microbiology, pathology, and genetics. A significant advantage is its link to the hospital's pneumatic dispatch tubes, which delivers sample almost immediately to the laboratory for analysis. "Having the laboratory directly in the hospital and a digital platform doctors can use makes results available immediately after analysis and clinical validation. Digitizing and connecting laboratory technology to the platform removes the human factor and reliably guarantees flawless transmission of results to patients and hospital clients," said Veronika Dudova, head of Bory's new Unilabs Slovakia laboratory.

The new clinical biochemistry and haematology laboratories, along with the pathology laboratory, are equipped with the most modern medical technology from suppliers such as Siemens Healthineers, Roche, Mindray, Sysmex, BioG, and Biomerieeux. What is new will be ten previously unavailable treatments and procedures like drugs and expanded toxicological examinations of a patient's blood and urine.

"2023 is going to be a critical year for us in terms of a new corporate strategy and plans. An important pillars is the upgrading of the equipment in all our laboratories, and so I am particularly proud of us being able to offer our customers Slovakia's most modern facilities ever, including the new diagnostic laboratory at Bory Hospital," Stanislav Carsky, Unilabs Slovakia CEO, additionally mentioned.

Unilabs Slovakia is also launching this year Aptio, its second fully automatic analytical line, which can carry out 8,720 examinations in an hour. In the first half of 2023, its state-of-the-art collection point for self-paying patients, lab.online, will be also starting operations in the Bratislava NIDO project.
